**Residential Trip 2019– PGL Multi Activity**  
**Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019 – Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

As you will be aware, during their final year at Horndon School, Year 6 pupils are offered the opportunity to go on a residential trip and we have secured the opportunity to go to a Multi activity venue in Liddington Wiltshire for 5 days.

***The cost of the trip is anticipated to be between £460.00 - £480.00***

*We would respectfully request a **non-refundable deposit of £50.00** to be in school by **15<sup>th</sup> June 2018** in order to secure your child's place. Without this deposit we cannot reserve or guarantee your child's place on the trip as this is a set fee required by the company themselves.*

*A further **£100 non-refundable deposit** will then be due by **13<sup>th</sup> July 2018**.*

*We then propose 3 instalments when your child is in Year 6.*

*1<sup>st</sup> Instalment of **£115** by **20<sup>th</sup> November 2018***

*2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment of **£115** by **15<sup>th</sup> January 2019***

*Final payment of **£80-£100.00** by **28<sup>th</sup> February 2019** (final payment to be confirmed)*

***Please log onto SIMs Agora to make your payments and give your permission.***

Please note, attendance on the residential is subject to children displaying the Core Values and Code of Conduct. Behaviour that does not meet these standards could affect the chances of your child being able to attend.

If you or the school make the decision to withdraw your child, please be reminded that your deposit of £150 will be forfeited.

As we have suggested in the past, the children may open an account at the school bank, if they haven't already done so, as an excellent means of saving and budgeting for the trip.
