Next Week in English

Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 are continuing their work on characterisation. They will be using what they have learnt to plan and write their own work. They will be looking at using 'show not tell' to add more details.

Year 4

Next week in English, Year 4 will be putting into practice all the techniques learnt in this unit to write their final characterisation. They will also review and practice English skills they have learnt so far this year.

Year 5

Year 5 are discovering a new text, 'The Chocolate Factory'. They will be finding out the type of text, and some features of it, before planning their own version.

Next Week in Maths

Year 3

Next week, we will start to multiply by multiples of ten. This will include exploring the effect of scaling by ten and the effect of this on place value.

Year 4

Next week, Year 4 will be learning to add and subtract with decimals using regrouping and formal written methods. They will learn to compare strategies and then use these methods to solve problems involving money.

Year 5

Next week in Year 5 maths, we will be learning about percentages, finding percentages of amounts and relating them to tenths and hundredths.
