As part of a Forest School session your child will have the opportunity to make a fire without matches, use tools to create, build shelters, explore, play games, cook on an open fire and make lasting memories.

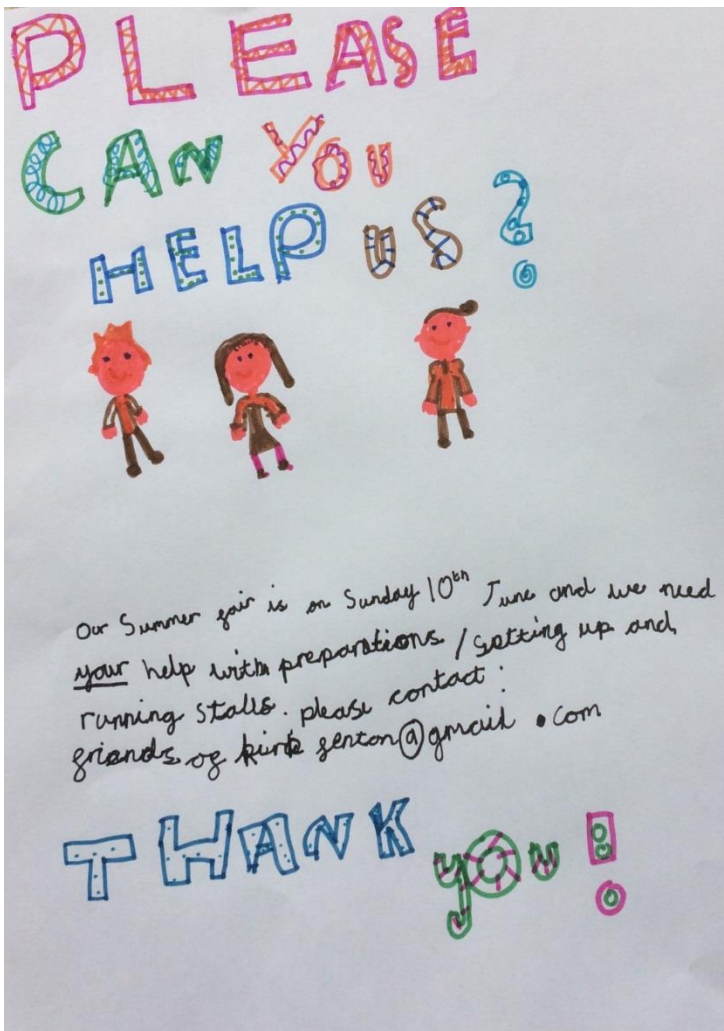
The session will be run by Siobhan Bamforth who is level 3 Forest School trained and leads outdoor learning at Kirk Fenton Primary School.
