History:

- Viking Anglo-Saxon struggle for Kingdom of England. Explore what Britain was like before the first Viking invasions.
- How Viking Invasions affected Anglo Saxon settlements.
- Why was King Alfred called 'The Great'?
- What was life like for the Vikings?
- How did Britain become a unified country?
- End of the Anglo Saxon and Viking Era in Britain.

Geography:

- Europe related to Invasions - Angles, Saxons, Jutes, Vikings, Celts
- Use maps, atlas' and globes to identify countries and regions of settlements within UK.
- Eight points of a compass, four and six-figure grid references, symbols and key (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world
