	<p>The ministers will be working to achieve the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record short video clips to introduce the 7 values awards at the Trust Awards Evening on 18 July 2018 • Draft a list of “20 experiences in a Flying High school” – pupil entitlement of activities and experiences <p>In preparation for the session, please could ministers be supported in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thinking about experiences they would like to see included in this “passport” for all pupils – experiences, activities, challenges etc – we will talk to the ministers in more detail on the day about this task but it would be good if they had had an initial conversation. • Prepare a short sentence ready to practice and record at the session. Schools have been allocated a value and will practice this with your staff and Trust staff at the venue ready to be filmed live in the concert hall! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Think about the value and what does it mean to you and your school. We want the children to speak from the heart and don’t want them to read from a script. Each clip will begin with them saying, “This award celebrates [name of value]. In our school [value] means... each child to then have a short sentence, phrase or example (literally just a few seconds each so all feel confident and not over-whelmed).
