The children will be enjoying a day of celebrations in preparation for the Royal Wedding. Wear **Red, White and Blue** and bring in £1.00 for School Fund.

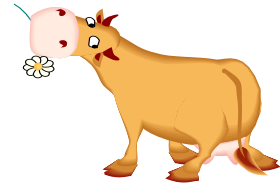
School Leavers Trip - Tuesday 12th June
