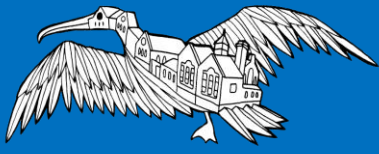
We have a packed Summer Term in the lead up to the end of the year. Please see over for some key dates for your diaries.
