

## Attendance and Lateness

- We would like to remind parents of the importance of good attendance. Many parents are surprised how quickly a few days' absence regularly taken can add up. Absence from school for whatever reason can unsettle children and leave gaps in their knowledge of the curriculum.

**Statistically, it has been proven that pupils with lower than average attendance at primary school will underachieve at GCSE.**

- Likewise, being on time for school is very important, as children who arrive late miss out on learning opportunities. At Sunny Bank Primary School, we concentrate on key skills in English and maths at the beginning of the school day. If your child arrives late at school (after 8.50am), they must be brought to the school office by a parent/carer to be signed in and an explanation will need to be recorded. Please be aware that persistent, severe or unexplained lateness can be classed as unauthorised absence and may be referred to the Local Authority.
