All HGPS players were outstanding and made us all so proud. Particular congratulations go to Solomon Jatta who was voted Man of the Match.

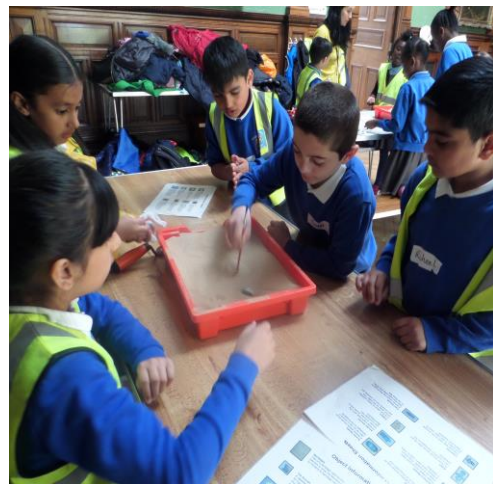


## Bagshaw Museum Trip
