Next Week in English

Year 3

Next week in English, Year 3 will be starting to learn a new non-fiction text linked to our topic on the Romans. We will be learning how to write and present information.

Year 4

Next week in English, Year 4 will be examining explanation texts. They will identify key features of this type of text and use these when planning and writing their own explanations. Pupils will also explore conjunctions and their use.

Year 5

Year 5 will be working on their own information texts next week about characters from 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'.

Year 6

Next week, Year 6 will be learning to write a quality narrative. The classes will have to include figurative language, adjectives, adverbs and a range of punctuation.

Next Week in Maths

Year 3

Next week, we will complete our work on multiplying by multiples of ten and begin to multiply two-digit numbers by ones using the distributive law.

Year 4

Next week, Year 4 will be learning to subtract with decimals using regrouping and formal written methods. We will learn to compare strategies and then use these methods to solve problems involving money.

Year 5

Next week in Year 5, we will be using our knowledge of finding percentages to solve problems.

Year 6

Next week, Year 6 will be continuing to learn about pie charts and other ways of representing and interpreting data. They will also be revising other areas of the curriculum in preparation for Year 7.
