Y3 and Y5 and KS1 children all experienced fantastic learning linked to their topics down in forest school at Buckland Brewer. Buckland Brewer children have visited Exmoor Zoo, kindly sponsored by Fun Club which used to run after school at Buckland Brewer. Our Y6's have had an opportunity to show their resilience when faced with the challenge of SATs- we are so proud of their super attitude to learning, and our teachers are busy completing other assessments for all the children.

Two really interesting workshops have been offered to parents; Developing number sense with Numicom and the Growth Mindset. I think it fair to say that the parents who did attend found the sessions fun, and very informative. Thank you to all who came. I understand that child care, and sunny weather are factors which have prevented more parents from taking up these opportunities so we are taking this into account when we plan future events for next term.

The new adventure play area @ Buckland Brewer has been a great success with the children enjoying that every day and I am very pleased to say that FOPs at Parkham have been busy applying for grants to develop the grassy area at the front of the school. Due to this work they have been awarded over £10,000 in grants and so the order for further equipment for that area will be placed soon. Thank you to all the support and effort that both FOPS and FOBBs do to raise money by organising such fun events- including films nights which are very popular with the children.

Buckland is all set to expand to three classes by bringing the preschool on site and creating an additional classroom within the main building. This remodelling work is now likely to start just before the end of the Summer Term.

We have and are welcoming two new staff members- Miss Sophie Evans, Foundation stage practitioner who has joined the Early Years Team and Parkham and Miss Bethany Piper- Early Years Teacher who will join the team at Buckland in September.

We have a very busy term ahead, with both visitors and visits plans, parents forums, welcome meetings for new reception children parents, sports events, end of year productions, so please keep your eye on the website, newsletter, mobile APP and notice boards so you don't miss what's coming up. Have a wonderful break and we look forward to seeing you all on the 4th June.
