### **Raisin Flapjacks**

#### **Ingredients**

250g Porridge Oats  
125g butter  
60 g demerara sugar  
1 TBS golden syrup  
1 tsp salt

Oven setting 180 C / 350 F / Gas 4

Grease shallow oblong tin 18 x 28 cm / 7 x 11  
inches

#### **Method**

Melt butter, sugar and syrup together, over a  
very low heat

Stir them together with a wooden spoon

Take the pan off the heat, add oats, raisins and  
salt to the mixture and stir well

Pour the mixture into the baking tin, press it  
down and bake for 20 minutes

Cut the flapjacks into squares

When they are cool take out of the baking tin  
Store in a biscuit tin

### **Viennese Whirls**

#### **Ingredients**

175 g (6oz) unsalted butter  
40 g (1 ½oz) icing sugar  
175 g (6oz) plain flour  
40 g (1 ½oz) cornflour  
1 tbsp vanilla extract

#### **Method**

1. Into a mixing bowl, add butter, icing sugar,  
plain flour, cornflour and vanilla extract.  
Whisk until smooth. Chill mixture for  
15min.
2. Prepare a piping bag with a large star nozzle  
and put in a jug to hold steady. Spoon  
biscuit mix into piping bag and twist top to  
secure bag and push mixture to bottom.
3. Line baking sheet with baking parchment.  
Make rounds by piping in a spiral shape,  
from centre outwards, to about 6.5cm  
(2½in) in diameter.
4. Bake at 180°C (160°C fan) mark 4 for 12-  
15min until biscuits look pale golden and  
feel firm. Leave to cool completely on tray.
