

How to help at home

Read with your child daily and when reading support them to identify the key parts:

How is it introduced?

Where is it set?

What is the problem?

How is it resolved?

Discuss their favourite character(s).

Ask your child questions about what they have read, using different vocabulary, to ensure they have a deeper understanding.

Point out the different words that end in the suffixes -ing, -est, -er and -ed and words that start with the prefix -un.

Remember to point out the high frequency words so your child is able to recognise and read them with ease, and practise writing and spelling them.

Keep practising the different Read Write Inc Phonic sounds to help your child read and recognise words with those sounds in. Remember to refer to the sheet give out in parents evening for the rhymes to match the sounds.

Help your child to write more complex sentences using adjectives, connectives, different sentence openers and punctuation, such as commas for a list and exclamation marks.

The **massive, grey** castle had an **iron gate as heavy as an elephant**.

The **large** castle had 12 **huge** bedrooms and 7 **small** bathrooms.

Work together and design a new castle.

What would your castle look like?

How many entrances would it have?

How many guards would you have?

How many turrets would you have?

Would you have a drawbridge?

What would you name your castle?

Continue to practise reading, writing and recognising numbers to 100 and beyond. Help your child to add two, 2 digit numbers using a hundred square. Remember to jump forwards/backwards in 10's using the hundred square.

Learn to read, write and say the 100 high frequency words and common exception words. Please help your child to recognise, read and spell the high frequency words and common exception words, as this year there has been a huge push on spelling and punctuation. Thank you!

Term 6 Turrets and Tiaras



In term 6 we will continue our learning journey as we head into the topic of Turrets and Tiaras.

During Term 6 we will be learning to:


Re-read what we have written to check that it makes sense. We will be learning to correct our errors using a 'purple polishing pen' to show that we have made corrections.




Explore how to make simple mechanisms (e.g. levers and sliders). We will be creating a pop up book.



Use a blank number line to help us add and subtract, using partitioning (breaking the number into tens and ones). We will also continue to learn how to count forwards and backwards in 10's from any given number.



Use the copy and paste buttons, including the shortcut controls. Ctrl c for copy and Ctrl v for pasting.


