Dear parents/carers,

We would like to correct an error on the school calendar for 2018-19 which was sent out yesterday with the weekly newsletter. There were 2 initial drafts of the Wakefield Local Authority calendar and we have circulated the incorrect one. We apologise for any confusion this may have caused, and would like to thank the parent who brought this very promptly to our attention.

At Easter, we will be breaking up on Friday 5th April at 3pm, with children returning to school on Tuesday 23rd April. The previous calendar showed pupils breaking up on Friday 12th April and returning on Monday 29th April.

Because of the change, we have changed one of our INSET days so that there is not a 1- or 2-day week in July. Hopefully, this will also help parents/carers find cheaper deals on holidays outside of our term time when other children are still at school.

The INSET days will now be as follows:

- Monday 3rd September
- Tuesday 4th September

School opens for pupils on Wednesday 5th September, a day earlier than stated on the newsletter.

- Friday 3rd May

Unchanged and allows for an extended bank holiday weekend.

- Monday 22nd July
- Tuesday 23rd July

School will close for pupils at 3pm on Friday 19th July to end the academic year.

Once again, we apologise for any inconvenience or confusion this may have caused, and we ask that you destroy any copies of the incorrect calendar to prevent confusion in the future.
