ST. AGNES' REPAIRS: There are bound to be hiccups in the next month, but we hope people will be inconvenienced as little as possible. To ensure so, we ask that everyone observes requested arrangements meticulously, made out of health and safety requirements, Common Sense, and care for all. If anyone experiences a particular difficulty then please contact Fr. J. Take as a general rule that - apart from Times of Mass and Services - NO ONE has access to the Site other than those with previously Authorised Access from Fr. J / Mr. Bernard Mannion. Given this notice, even at times of Mass/Services, the Diocese and Parish disclaims all responsibility for any damage caused to Persons/vehicles parked on St. Agnes' property in the duration of this work.

A letter, informing The Warden of Ridings Court of commencement of work, all NO parking arrangements, and regretfully the suspension in this period of our agreed usual exception only for the pick-up and setting down of disabled/infirm residents was placed on the Warden's Office door on Saturday, 26th May, as access and direct contact was unable to be gained.

The letter requested that the Warden inform "Places for People" Authorities, all Residents - and then they inform their families/Carers/visitors of the necessary arrangements which will be rigorously implemented. The Emergency Services will, of course, continue their right of entry in all emergencies.

Parishioners are respectfully requested NOT to park in the Addison Court Private Car Park, and reminded they risk a parking fine should they park their vehicle on the road/pavement outside Church property on Main Road, the B3167. Otherwise we ask that all courteously park in the surrounding streets, respecting the needs of all our neighbouring residents.
