It was very clear that over the course the children learnt a lot about healthy living and exercise and they have built on the A-life course from last year	Potentially book them again for next year or even every two years. The course was very good but the healthy living day was very similar to the year before. If they could change the course content slightly it would make a difference.
African dance day	£559	Feedback from staff and pupils	This gave the children a new and different cultural sports experience. Next year try and book a different culture or style.

A number of these children took part in an assembly to explain what they had watched and taken part in.</p>	<p>This was a very good trip for the children and it gave them a super insight into how disabilities do not mean you cannot be world class. I am in touch with the tennis association and should the ticket offer become available again then they will be applied for.</p>
Early years	£700	<p>Climbing frame and garden equipment. 80% met or exceeded the physical development goal. Teachers noticed how the children accelerated in this goal after purchasing the equipment and gross motor skills improved.</p>	<p>Development of the early years garden is ongoing, potentially it would be good to use some Sports premium money to further develop and replenish this area to continue gross motor growth and physical growth.</p>

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
