Please make sure that your child is appropriately dressed i.e. in School PE kit and wearing trainers or plimsoles and that they have a water bottle. Team caps will be distributed by the class teacher.

Please note parking at the Athletics ground is restricted and that if you park in the car park only use the bays marked with yellow or you will be clamped. We advise you walk, however if you do drive please use Wood Lane or Ridgeway Road to park. You can enter the Athletics ground via Wood Lane or alternatively there is an entrance opposite Isleworth and Syon School for Boys. You may wish to bring something to sit on as there is very little seating around the area.

For health and safety reasons all spectators are asked to remain outside the fenced area of the Athletics track for the duration of the event.

All our competitors will have the opportunity to take part in at least four events i.e. running, long jump, throwing the 'howler' and 'target hoops'. Following the first round of activities the athletes with the fastest running time, furthest jump, longest throw and most accurate throw in each of the five houses will then represent their team in the various Marlborough Sports Finals where the first three places will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. These will be presented at a special assembly.

On the reverse is a map of the track and the times and locations where each year group will be competing in the various events. Please note all times are approximate.

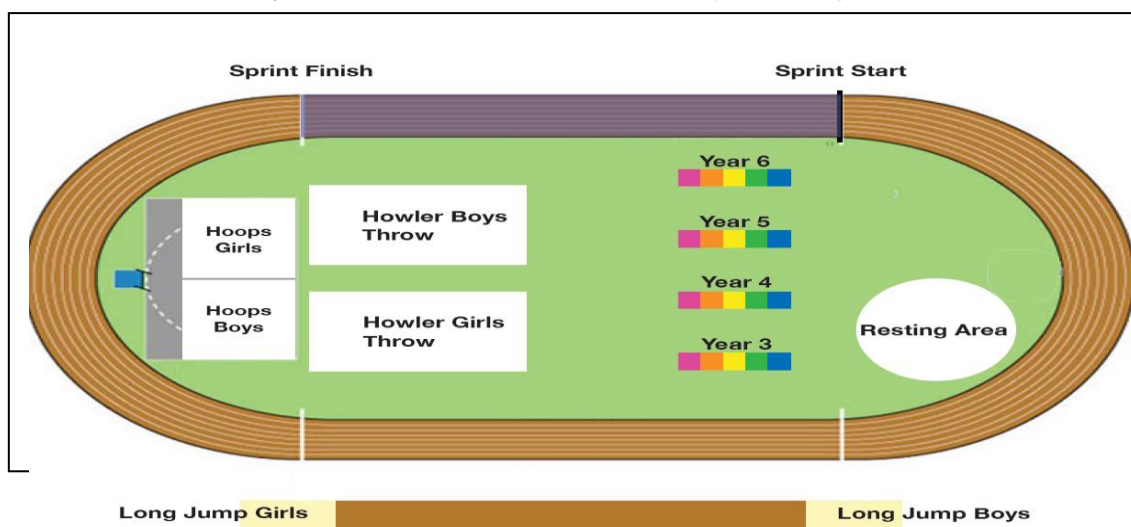
