Data Protection at Sutton Benger School

Many of you will be aware of the new GDPR duty which will be starting on 25th May. The school has to ensure that we are aware of the data we hold regarding children, staff and parents of the school as well as ensure we hold it safely and it is only used for the purpose that is needed for. An updated School Privacy Notice will be available on the Website and a version will be emailed to all parents by the end of this week.

For safeguarding purposes, the school holds a data collection sheet for each child which provides staff with emergency contact details and medical/allergy information. You will be receiving a copy of this data sheet and we ask that you all please check the current details the school holds and make any manual changes if required. **You will need to sign the form and return it to school by 4th June.** We will need 100% return of this form to confirm the current details are correct as quite often details change but the school is not informed. An email will be sent to let you know when the paper copies are in the bookbags.

A huge thank you to the staff who spent last Saturday morning at Seagry School helping the Year 5 and 6 netball and football team take part in the Small Schools Cluster Tournament. As we have been unable to find support to help us run these activities this year, the staff felt it was important to attend if we could and they offered to run some training sessions after school. The teams were not in the winning frame but they all competed well showing great team spirit.
