

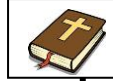
Maths

- Addition/subtraction and division/multiplication as inverse operations and learning of 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables including word problems
- Estimation
- Data handling (block graphs, bar charts, pictograms and tally charts)
- Revision of units of measurement
- Geometry (angles and turning movements) and symmetry



Religious Education

The children will become familiar with some stories from the New Testament told by Jesus and understand the purpose of parables. They will be 'digging deeper' into Understanding Christianity and will be focusing on the Creation unit of work.



Literacy

Key Texts - Katie Morag and the Two Grandmothers and The Emperor's Egg. Ideas from this text will be used to teach the different genres of writing. Those covered this half term will be story sequencing, postcards and character profiles. SPaG learning will include using expanded noun phrases, adverbs, exclamations, questions, verbs (present/ past tenses and the progressive form of verbs in the present/past tense) for singular possession of nouns.



History

The children will continue with the Great Fire of London. We will learn more about Samuel Pepys and find out about what eye-witnesses would have seen at the time of the Great Fire of London. We will learn about Florence Nightingale.

Geography

Children will make a pictorial map and learn to use a key. They will learn about the Continents and Oceans of the World.

Computing

We will continue to code simple games and programmes using Espresso Coding and children will create their own apps. Children will be learning to create and interpret databases.



Science

The children will compare what is alive, dead or never alive through the seven life processes. They will learn about different habitats and how plants and animals are suited to live in them including Emperor Penguins in Antarctica.



Music



The children will be learning about rhythms using conventional musical notation. They will be learning to play the recorder and to read simple music on the five line staff.

PSHE and SEAL



We will be exploring the relationships that are important to us including those of family and friends. We will learn to understand our own feelings as well as the feelings of others.

DT

We will continue with our work on making and evaluating a wooden framed house, measuring, sawing and joining sticks of balsa wood and design/make and sew hand puppets.

Art

The children will paint a picture of the Isle of Struay using colour mixing skills with powder paint.

We will be working on gymnastics routines including body management exercises. They will also learn throwing/catching skills involving different apparatus.
