Open Evening

Our Opening Evening takes place this year on Wednesday 18th July from 3.30pm to 5.30pm. This is an opportunity for you to informally visit your child's present class teacher and look at their achievements this year and a chance to visit the new classroom and meet the new teacher.

Heritage Week

You will see from the diary dates that we have planned a special week entitled Heritage Week. This will focus on our local area. Each class will research and study something special in the locality. There will be an opportunity to join in with your child's class during the week and a presentation to parents. Watch out for the invitation.

This special week in school will be linked to our Sports Days. Each class will represent a country on sports day. They will be learning about the country-its characteristics, food, music and art.

Maths Parents Session

Over this half term we will be inviting parents into school to join in with their child's maths lesson. This is an invaluable opportunity for parents to see how we learn Maths at Hollingwood. Collecting Your Child from school

Children's safety is of paramount importance to us. With this in mind you must ensure that you adhere to the following when collecting your child at the end of the day:-

- Children must be collected by a responsible adult
- We do not allow children to leave school with an adult who is unknown to us
- If your collection arrangements change, even at short notice, you must contact the school office and advise us of the new arrangements

These guidelines help us to ensure that children from Nursery to Key Stage 2 are safe and we appreciate your continued support.

Sandals

It is lovely to see the children in their summer sandals. As they get such little wear out of these, we are not as concerned about the colour as we normally are about their school shoes. Please do not buy sandals with **high heels, slippery soles or no backs** as these can cause injury on a busy playground.

Water Bottles

Particularly as the weather gets warmer, it is really very important that your child continues to drink water throughout the day; research has shown it improves brain power- so make a special effort to make sure your child has a water bottle in school every day.

Sun Sense

If you wish your child to wear sun protection during the hot weather, please send in the cream with your child's name clearly written on it. We are not allowed to apply the cream so please show your child how to do it. It is sensible for the children to wear sun hats. Please do not send caps with long, very hard peaks, as these have caused injury to other children when they run into each other.
