

SUBJECT & OBJECT OF A VERB



The **subject** of a verb is the person, people, thing or things doing the action in the sentence. The **object** of the verb is the person, people, thing or things that are having the action done to them.

I cleaned **the car.**
↑ subject ↑ verb ↑ object

SUBJECT	VERB	OBJECT
I	love	weekends
you	learn	English
she	rides	a bike

He paints **posters.**
↑ Subject ↑ Verb ↑ Object

Subject
Who or what performs the action of the verb is the *subject*.

Verb
The verb is the word that expresses *what that action is*.

Object
Whoever or whatever receives that action is the *object*.

More examples highlighting the **subject**, **verb** and **object** in each sentence:

John was reading **that book.**

Leicester City play **many matches** each season.

Every December, **the choir** perform **songs** at the Menphys Carol Concert.
