We kindly ask parents/carers to donate a food dish that can be shared, maybe something from your home country but remember we are nut free school. We will put up a list up nearer the time.

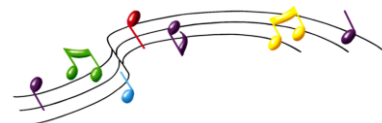
Peter Jaaniste will be joining us for the rest of this term as site care officer. Please help us to make Peter feel welcome.



Sing-A-Long Dates

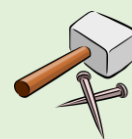

Regular Reminders:

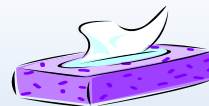
Fruit for snack:
