## Reception Summer 2 Term

### Maths

In our Maths work we are working on:

- Continuing solving addition and subtraction money problems
- Counting, reading and writing numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Lots of problem solving using adding and subtraction puzzles.
- Solving problems, including doubling, halving and sharing to 20.
- Solving problems with patterns e.g. symmetry
- Counting in 10s and 2s
- Number bonds to 10 (ie.  $9+1=10$   $6+4=10$ )

### Literacy / Phonics

We will continue with our Ruth Miskin phonics every morning.

In our Literacy work we will look at the following stories, 'Bog Baby', 'Rosie's walk', 'Dear Zoo' 'The Giraffe who couldn't dance' and 'Tinka Tanka Scunk'. Through these stories we will develop our use of language to imagine and recreate roles. In our writing we will work on writing some irregular common words (red). We will also be working on developing our sentence writing by adding describing words to our simple sentences to make them super sentences. Writing lists, poems, rhyming and looking at a story structure. Retelling of our trip to Tropical World and Den building day.

### Amazing Animals, Art, PE and IT

We will be looking at many different animals and where they live and what they eat. We will classify them in different ways such as scales, fur, and feathers which are mammals or reptiles. In the woods we will identify leaves, plants and any mini beasts that we can find. We will learn why insects such as bees are important in our environment. We will talk about how to look after animals and what could make a good pet. During the term we will be planting our own vegetables to be eaten later in the year. In our artwork we will look at different types of texture and artists such as Andy Goldsworthy for inspiration.

We will continue with the Thongsbridge Tennis Club coach in P.E on a Thursday and on a Friday we are practising athletics/games skills with a coach from Project Sport .

If at home you could identify all the technology you have and their uses such phones, ipads, tablets computers, cameras and any other gadgets you may this will help us with our technology part of the curriculum as we don't have access to all these items in school.

### Other useful information

**P.E** - Thursday (Tennis) and Friday - Please make sure your child has their P.E kit in school on these days.

**Reading books** - Reading and library books will be changed once a week on a Wednesday. Please record when you read with your child at home in their reading diaries, and have these at school daily, along with reading books and book bags.
