Staffing for 2018 /2019

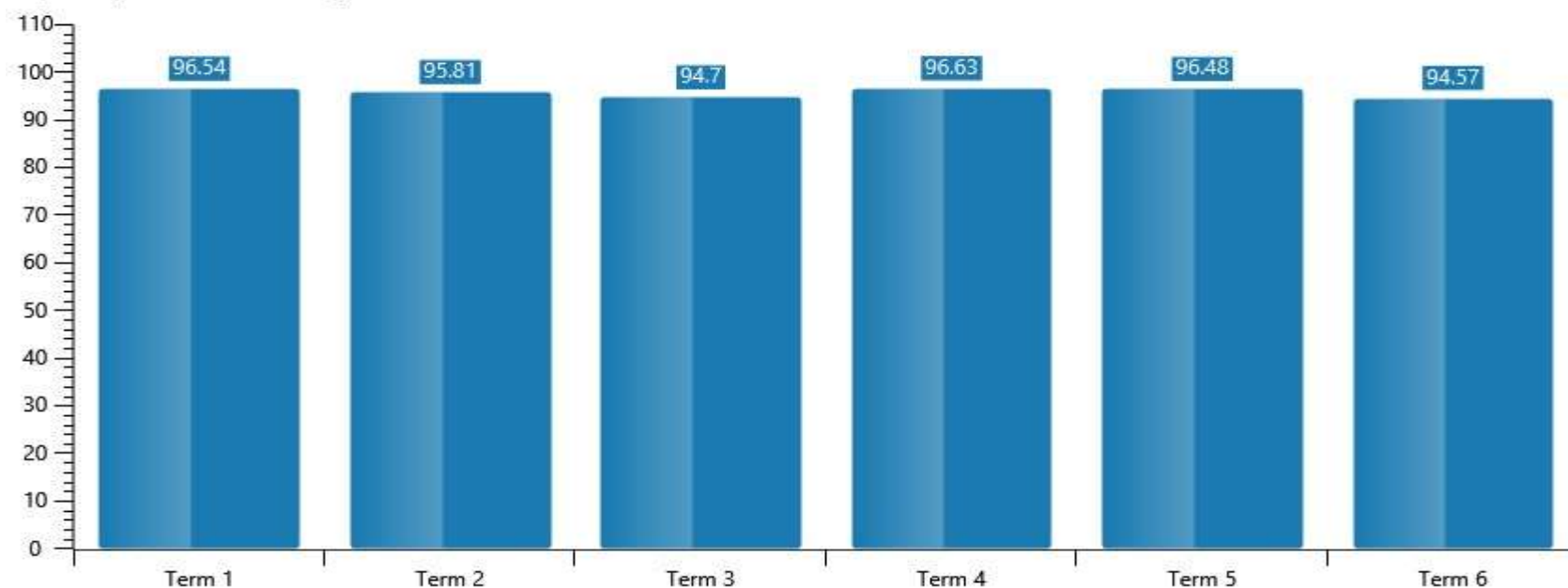

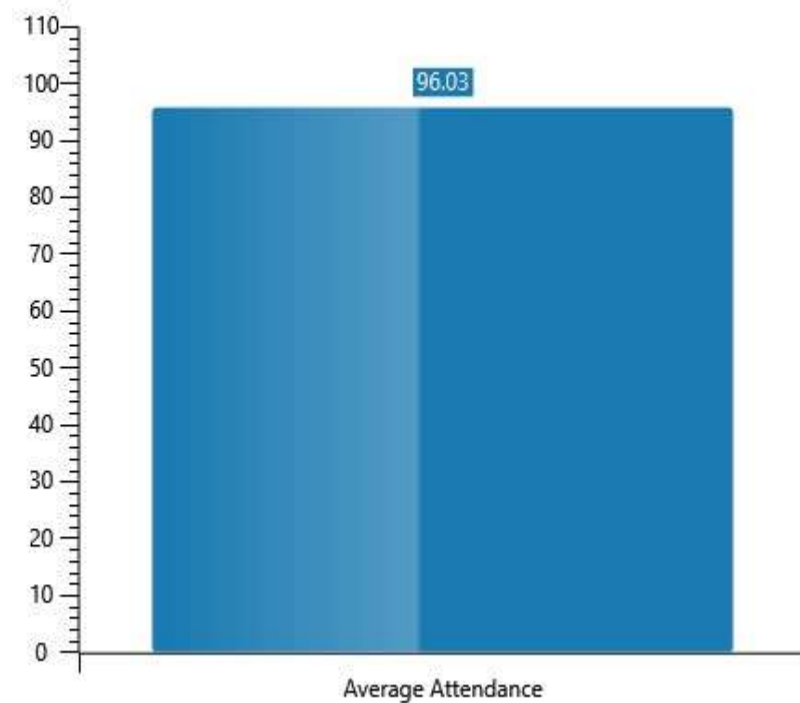
Percentage Session Attendance by Half Term
