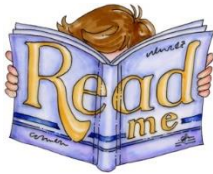


In English we will be learning to...

- Learn the 44 phonemes (sounds) and their related graphemes (letter shapes)
- Read words containing –s, -es, -ing, -ed, -er and –est endings
- Read common exception words e.g. friend
- Learn to appreciate rhymes and poems and recite some by heart
- Understand which letters belong to which handwriting family
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Join words and clauses by using ‘and’
- Begin to learn how to use question marks and exclamation marks



In Science we will be learning to...

- Work scientifically e.g. observe closely and use simple equipment
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees
- Identify and describe a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their physical properties
- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies



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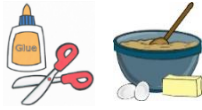
In Maths we will be learning to...

- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens
- Use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
- Solve missing number problems such as $7 = \square - 9$
- Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and arrays with support
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume, time
- Recognise and name a range of 2D and 3D shapes



What else can you do at home?

- Read your reading book every day and ask someone to ask you questions about what might happen next in the story
- Practise your spellings and sounds
- Practise your number bonds
- Practise your 1 and 10 times tables
- Conduct research about hospitals and nursing and bring any topic related items into school
- Draw portraits of your family and friends



In Design Technology we will be learning to...

- Communicate our ideas through a simple annotated drawing when designing a 'Box Hospital'
- Apply cutting, joining and finishing techniques to a range of materials and build a stable structure
- Peer evaluate our work



In Computing we will be learning to...

- Begin to understand how to stay safe online and be able to create a secure password
- Combine text and narration into a photo story



In History we will be learning to...

- Explain the events of Florence Nightingale's life and understand the contribution she made to national history

- Why should we care for others?

In Art and Design we will be learning to...

- Use line, space, shape and colour
- Use thick brushes for large spaces and thin brushes for fine detail
- Hold scissors correctly and turn the paper when cutting to make a paper silhouette
- Compare the portraits of Modigliani, Van Gogh and Da Vinci and describe the techniques used by silhouette and scissor artists



In PE we will be learning to...

- Improve our skills of running and jumping in Athletics and Games and play team games with fairness, co-operation and sportsmanship



In Geography we will be learning to...

- Handle a compass and use compass directions correctly
- Use directional language e.g. near, far, right
- Create a simple map and key



In Music we will be learning to...

- Work together as a group when singing, listening to one another to keep pitch and rhythm; find the pulse when listening to music
