

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back after the half term. We hope you all had a pleasant break and are looking forward to our final term before the summer holiday.

You may already have gathered from your child that we have started to work on our new topic which is **Water**. We will be basing all our activities around the theme, looking at animals which live in or near water, uses of water for health and hygiene and properties of water. It will also allow us to link neatly into the summer holidays, by thinking about the sea, and holidays by the sea!

We will continue to use our Question of the week approach, and our questions will be as follows:

Week beginning 4th June 'What animals can you name that live in water?'

Week beginning 11th June: 'What animals did Noah take on the Ark?'

Week beginning 18th June: 'What do you use water for at home?'

Week beginning 25th June: 'How do you use water to keep clean?'

Week beginning 2nd July: 'What do we find in a pond?'

Week beginning 9th July: 'What do you see on the beach?'

Week beginning 16th July: 'Are you doing anything special over Summer?'

Unbelievably, your child's time with us in the Potting Shed is now drawing to an end, so we are beginning to plan for their smooth transition into the Foundation Stage Unit. Building on the successful transition programme we offered our pupils last year, we will be holding 3 days of transition activities to help children to get to know their new class teachers and classmates and to feel happy and confident about the next stage in their school career. This will take place week beginning 2nd July.

Later in the term we will also be informing you about a meeting for parents and carers which will give *you* further information about the transition to the Foundation Stage. This will be on:
