Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the final term of the year.

We have an incredibly busy term ahead of us, particularly for year 6 who have lots to fit in before leaving us for the next part of their learning journeys.

This term we have: phonics screening, sports week, class trips, key stage trips, bikeability, thank you tea party, sports day, school reports, leavers disco and leaver's service to name just a few of the activities we will be participating in.

Whilst Hurstwood, Kemsley and Oakwood are continuing their topics from the previous term: Rainforests, Harry Potter and Eragon. Fir tree and Forge have both begun their new topics of:- Spot the difference between countries and Happy Holidays.

The final arrangements for key stage 2 for September have now been put in place. The children will be working mainly within their year group for maths and English in the morning. For the afternoon learning we are being very radical with two parallel classes made up of a mixture of children from years 3, 4, + 5, where all topic based learning will be taking place. The children have been put into friendship groups for the afternoon learning. These groupings will be the children's 'form' class where they will be registered. Although due to the setting in the mornings only their afternoon learning may take place in.
