Summer Weather

As always the British weather is extremely unpredictable. If we should have sunshine please ensure your child wears sun cream, has a hat and brings water to school. Children may bring sun cream if it has their name on and they are able to apply it themselves. Alternatively, warm clothing and a coat may be necessary!
