National Space Centre Trip

As you may be aware, our topic in Year 4 this term is 'Up, Up and Away'. In Science, we will be learning about Space. With this in mind, we thought what better place to take the children then to the National Space Centre in Leicester. With six interactive galleries, the UK's largest planetarium, unique 3D Simulator Experience and the iconic 42m high Rocket Tower, the award-winning National Space Centre is an out of this world experience.

The date for this will be Wednesday IIth July 2018, leaving school at 8.15am and returning back at Short Heath at around 4pm. The children will be required to wear school uniform so can easily be recognised. They will also need to bring a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles.) Payment must go through our secure online service called Parentpay, which is now our preferred method of payment for trips by credit or debit card. Parents who need to continue making payments by cash may do so by using the paypoint network at local convenient stores, (please ask at the school office if you require this method of payment). Please be assured that Parentpay offers the highest security and no card details are stored on the system or are accessible by the school or Parentpay.
