

## Art

This term we will be working on our drawing and painting skills. We will explore what media we can use to create different effects. We will also use paint to create different textures and use a range of colours.

## PE

We will be developing creating and performing dances using a range of movement patterns, including those from different times, places and cultures.

## Maths

In maths we will continue to master how to solve calculations using all of the four operations. We will widen our knowledge of number through puzzles, problems, shape, space and measures. We will continue to progress to gain a place on the times table star of the week display.

## Design Technology

This term we will be focussing on food and the principle of a varied and healthy diet. We will be learning how cooking is a crucial life skill and develop our basic cooking skills. We will use what we have learnt to prepare and cook a variety of dishes for ourselves and how this compares to the diet of an animal. As part of the life of a farmer we will design and create healthy and varied meals for farmers.

## Science

In science we will be learning about plants. We will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant. We will investigate the way in which water is transported within plants. Finally we will find out which plants animals eat and why.



## Year 3: Farm Life

## Computing

During this half term we will be focussing on creativity and designing.

We will be creating puzzles and quizzes about farm animals focussing on changing parameters as well as learning and creating databases.

## RE

We will continue to learn about Hinduism beliefs. As well as reflect upon our own beliefs, values, attitudes, feelings and experiences.

## PSHE

In PSHE we will be focussing on relationships and changes as we enter the last half term of year 3.

## Literacy

This term we will be writing a range of different texts such as diary entries, persuasive letters and setting descriptions.

Through our writing we will continue to develop our spelling, grammar and punctuation skills.

We will be reading and analysing non-fiction texts, looking at key features and how we can find information. We will compare books on farm animals and evaluate them, reflecting upon how well we can find information, how interesting they are, the writers choice of language and think how we could improve them.

We will also be focusing the narrative of Charlotte's Web and exploring and reflecting upon the text during Literacy and Guided reading.

## Music

In music we will be learning to play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using our voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression we will compose our animal melodies using tuned and untuned instruments.
