HEALTH AND SAFETY – We have had reports from residents of the caravan park, that there are parents/carers parking on the dropped kerb by the old vicarage and on the zig zags outside school. For the safety of all, please can you ensure that anyone who picks up or drops off (including relatives and childminders) are made aware that we kindly request that alternative parking is found. Mrs Hardman on the crossing patrol also finds it very difficult to cross children safely if cars are parked on the main road.

Could I also request that we draw your attention to the guidelines which request that the church car park, including the disabled spaces and the area outside the main church door are not used by people picking up and dropping off unless a specific request has been made to school. This week school staff witnessed parents/relatives reversing out from the spaces when children were running past.

FURTHER HEALTH AND SAFETY - Can we request that children do not play on the steps and railings outside the new classroom or on the walls surrounding the school or church before or after school. All children know that this is not allowed during the school day but have been seen on them this week. Can we request that children are well supervised before 8.55am and after 3.15pm.
