

## History and Geography

The children be learning about various historical figures that have inspired change and made a difference to the world today.

This will include people from lots of different fields of study such as scientists, explorers, pioneers and leaders of business.

## Maths

The children will:

- Learn and recall their times tables.
- Learn about shapes and their properties including lines of symmetry.
- Learn how to read time, both 12 and 24 hour clock and solve time problems.
- Review and recap on their prior learning from this year, consolidating any areas as necessary.

## English

The children will:

- Debate, both orally and written, the positives and negatives of how women gained the right to vote.
- Use the book *The Fantastic Flying Books of Mr Morris Lessmore* by W.E. Joyce, to inspire our creative writing.
- Use the biographies and autobiographies of inspirational people to produce factfiles.

## P.S.H.E.

In P.S.H.E. the children will be focusing on friendships, relationships and bullying. They will discuss what makes a good friend and how to deal with negative behaviour.

## Art and Design

**Music:** The children will 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' their music learning from this year. They will revise music vocabulary and perform the music they have learnt.

## Art and Design and Technology

## Science

### Light

The children will study the inventions of Thomas Edison, in particular the invention of the lightbulb. They will consider how such a simple invention as this, has affected the lives of people dramatically.

## P.E.

**Rounders** - the children will develop their batting, fielding and teamwork skills.

**Athletics** - the children will learn the skills and techniques required for javelin, discus, shotput and sprinting.
