



French Year 4

Listen attentively and show an understanding of a range of familiar spoken sentences by joining in and responding. Engage in conversations by answering simple questions and give basic information. Speak in phrases and sentences using reasonable pronunciation and intonation. Present information orally to an audience. Read out a few familiar words and phrases with reasonable pronunciation and intonation. I can recognise and understand a few familiar words and phrases in written form.

I can write one or two short sentences to a model and can write some words from memory. Listen to and accurately repeat particular phonemes in songs, rhymes and poems and begin to make links to spellings.

Understand basic grammar appropriate to the topic being studied.

Term 1 and 2

Learn weather phrases.

Learn vocabulary of animals from the story Chèr Zoo (Dear Zoo).

Learn adjectives to describe animals.

Produce and read aloud a French story book.

Learn to use a bilingual French dictionary.

Term 3 and 4

Learn parts of the body

Learn vocabulary from the story of Pierre et Monsieur Bonhomme de Neige (Peter and Mr. Snowman)

Learn to tell the time using o'clock and half past.

Ask and answer questions about the time.

Learn daily routines including time.



Terms 5 and 6

Learn clothes

Describe clothes using colours as adjectives.

Learn sentences to write and perform the story *Je M'Habille et Je Te Croque*.

Learn vocabulary for places in a town.

Learn some items of food and drink to buy.
