## Next Week in English

### Year 3

Year 3's are continuing their non-fiction writing and will be producing an information leaflet using the skills they have learnt.

### Year 4

In English next week, Year 4 are going to be continuing their work with the myth 'Theseus and the Minotaur'. Pupils will identify the features of action and suspense writing. They will then plan and write their own version of the story.

### Year 5

Next week, Year 5 are going to be writing stories based on the text we have learnt. They are going to be re-writing the story from the view point of another character.

### Year 6

Next week, Year 6 will be learning to write a persuasive text. The pupils will have to include features such as: alliteration, facts, opinions, rhetorical questions, exaggeration, statistics and lists of three. They will also be using a variety of punctuation.

## Next Week in Maths

### Year 3

Next week, we will be revisiting the four operations - addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. Towards the end of the week, this will be taught in the context of money.

### Year 4

Year 4 will be learning to multiply two and three-digit numbers by one-digit numbers using the distributive law (with regrouping); moving on to learning how to use the formal written method for multiplication with regrouping in one or more columns.

They will then progress to long division with no regrouping.

### Year 5

Next week in maths, Year 5 will be developing their knowledge of problem solving using formal methods of multiplication and division.

### Year 6

The children in Year 6 are consolidating their knowledge of mathematical concepts that have been taught throughout the year.
