

## Mathematics

In maths they will be looking at metric and imperial measure and how they will convert between these by multiplying in powers of ten.

They will be revising aspects of number covered previously, focusing on place value and calculation strategies for division and multiplication.

Later in the term children will be focusing on Statistics which involves reading tables and graphs, analysing the results and making calculations based on the information they interpret

## History / Geography

This term, in History, Year 5 will be studying the lifestyles of the Vikings. They will explore their way of life including elements such as languages, homestead and battle strategies.

## Religious Education

The children will be looking at Buddhism, Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism and how these religions are expressed through different symbols, the Arts and Scripture. They will be examining how these Religions have similar or different beliefs to their own and how they can link them into their own lives

## Music

Children will learning how to play the Djembe drums which are originally from Africa. They will explore different ways of striking the drum, as well as experimenting with beat and rhythm. Later in the term the class will create and play their own piece of music

## Science

This term, children will be learning about Living things and Animals including Humans. Within Living things and their habitats we will study the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian and a bird as well as learning to describe the process of reproduction in some animals and plants. We will also be learning to describe the changes as humans reach old age

## MFL

In French, the children will be learning how to describe clothes using basic phrases.

**Topic: Vikings**

## P.E.

Children will be learning how to play Rounders and Cricket with a focus on throwing and catching, batting, fielding and strategy.

During the second half of the term the class will be enjoying Athletics, focusing on their running technique, as well as learning and developing their tennis skills.

## English

The children will be focusing on the story of Macbeth this term. They will analyse the feelings, thoughts and motives of the characters within the story. They will revisit persuasive writing and instructional writing as they move further into the story.

The class will be linking their reading skills to Macbeth by making predictions about the story, summarising key events and drawing inferences from characters or plot events in the story.

## D&T / Art

In art, the children will be looking at the work of different artists and creating pictures with different types of media.

In DT children will be designing, making and evaluating structures with a focus on bridges.

## Computing

In computing, the children will be looking at creating algorithms through 'Scratch' and create their own game which will include a maze. They will write their own programmes and debug them for mistakes.

## PSHE

Children will be exploring changes in their bodies which they will undergo as they get older, as well as focusing on transition and what they are looking forward to as they move into Year 6.
