Nursery Newsletter

Attendance and Punctuality

Every day of your child’s nursery education is important to your child. Please ensure they attend nursery every day.

We understand you may have other children that attend school, and it is difficult to get your child to nursery on time. Please can you make sure your child is in nursery as close to the start time as possible. Otherwise your child is missing important parts of their learning such as; group time.

Times are:

Morning: 8:45-11:45

Afternoon: 12:30-3:30

It is really important that you phone nursery and inform us if your child is not going to be attending nursery.

Parking

Please ensure you park respectfully. Leave yourself enough time to be able to park appropriately when collecting your child from nursery. There have been traffic wardens circulating within the local area.

Footwear

Please make sure your child is wearing footwear that enables them to run around, climb and participate in sporting activities. FLIPFLOPS are not suitable for wearing at nursery.

Sickness/Diarrhoea bugs

If your child is off Nursery because they have been vomiting (sick), or poorly tummy they need to stay off nursery for 48 hours (2 days) from the last time they were sick or had a poorly tummy.

Please can you make sure your child comes to nursery with a sunhat with their name inside? Please put sun cream **on** your child **before** they come for their nursery session.

It is important to protect your child from the UV rays.

The data law has changed and is now called GDPR. We have issued you with new consent forms to complete. This is to ensure we are GDPR compliant. Please return these forms as soon as possible.

Primary Schools

Please let us know which primary school your child is going to. This will enable us to ensure an effective transition to primary school, and nursery staff will meet with your child's new teacher.
