Dear Parents/Carers,

You may be aware that new laws designed to protect the rights of the individual in the modern information age came into effect from 25th May 2018. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) sets out stricter requirements for how we handle Personal Data (data that can be used to directly or indirectly identify an individual).

This is a positive development designed to help us all understand and control how our data and our children's data is being used. In our school it means that we need to communicate how we manage personal data and provide evidence that we are fulfilling our legal obligations.

Under the GDPR, we need to establish a lawful basis for using personal data. However, where a legal justification does not already exist; we need parental consent to use or share the personal data of our pupils.

Parental Consent: Curriculum Resources

We have a legal requirement to share our pupil data with the Department for Education, the Local Authority and other support organisations, but we also share some personal data to deliver our rich and varied curriculum. We only use the minimum amount of personal data that is necessary to perform a particular function - **often just a name**. We have chosen all our curriculum resource providers carefully and have evidence that they are GDPR compliant. We strongly feel that these resources are important to help us to deliver the high quality of education that you would expect from Scotts Primary School.

For assessment and planning purposes, we share some personal data (which is usually only name but sometimes date of birth. Please be assured we never share addresses or contact numbers) with the following systems:

2Build a Profile (2Simple): Early Years app that stores names, photographs and teacher notes on an external server to help assess children's progress through the EYFS curriculum.
