**Sports Day**

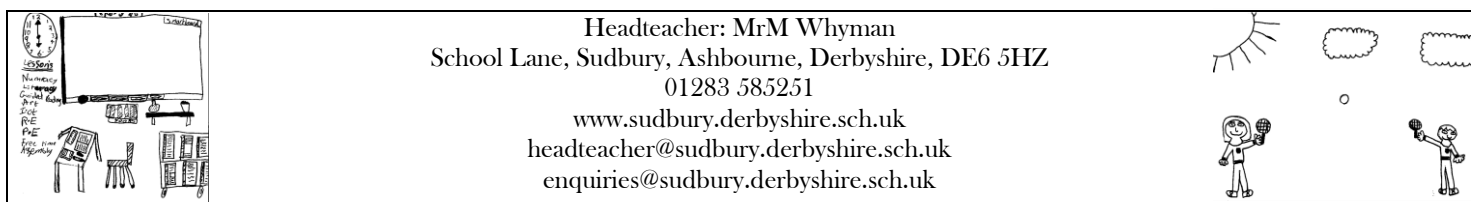

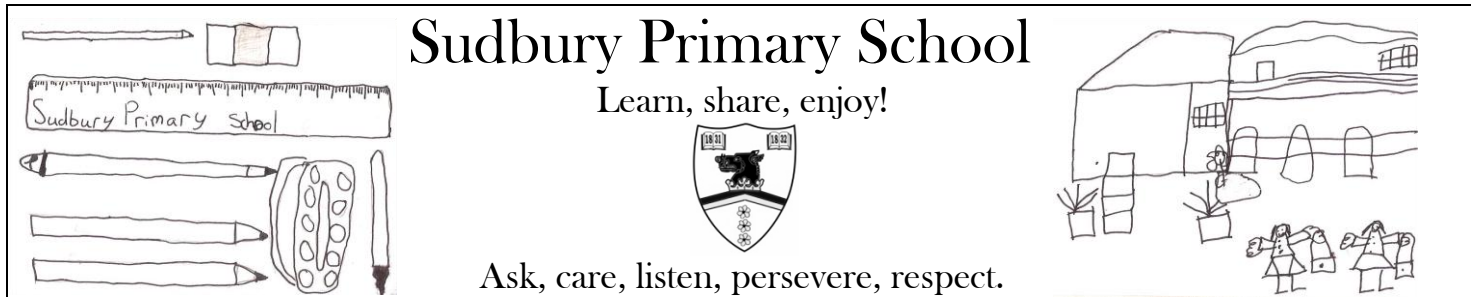
**Year 6 Girls - Women in to Engineering Workshop at The JCB Academy on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June**

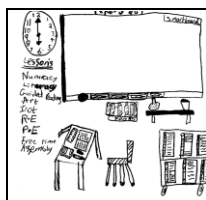
### Burton Albion Summer Holiday Courses
