Practical Parent Helpers

Practical Parent Helpers is a long established non-accredited course, developed by the WEA. This course will give students the knowledge, skills and understanding to support children's learning through a range of fun and practical activities

The course consists of three 1 day sessions, each with its own theme, during which students will explore a range of practical activities they can use to help support children's learning in the areas of English (including development of spoken language and reading skills); maths; science; social; emotional and behavioural development.

In addition, participants could also have the option to explore a different aspect of the school curriculum, such as ICT, PSHCE etc, or to benefit from the input of a visiting speaker.

Students will be encouraged to put into practice their ideas for supporting children's development and learning both at home and (possibly) as volunteers within a school.


