

## ENGLISH

In our English lessons, we will be exploring a range of writing genres including:

- Diary entries
- Letter writing
- Non-chronological reports
- Character/setting descriptions.

Spelling, Grammar and punctuation work including:

- Exploring parts of a sentence (nouns, verbs and adjectives)
- Exploring different types of sentences and how they can be used within writing.
- A range of prefixes (super-, anti-, auto-) and suffixes (-ment, -ness, -ed, -ly.)

## SCIENCE

### TOPIC TITLE:

In this unit children will explore what plants need to grow well. They will compare how plants grow in different soils and explore how fertilisers can be used to improve growth. Children will investigate the amount of water needed to help a leafy pot plant grow well. They will also investigate how space affects plant growth by comparing how well grass seeds grow with more or less space.



## MATHS

In our Maths lessons, we will be focusing on the following topics:

- Reading, writing, ordering and partitioning numbers to at least 1000
- Doubling and halving of two digit number
- Multiplying/dividing whole numbers by 10 and 100
- Addition / subtraction of two digit numbers
- Multiplication/division facts for 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
- Use of multiplication facts to multiply 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Division of 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Telling the time



## CORNERSTONES

Our Cornerstones curriculum topic for this half term is Gods and Mortals.

During this topic we will:

- Find out about Ancient Greece, Gods and Goddesses and the Spartan war.
- research and create Greek art and design
- Make a model of a Minator
- Read and write our own myths and legends
- write a diary as an Ancient Greek

In our Computing lessons, we will be learning about:

- Coding in scratch to make our own video games
- Use presentation software to present work.
