

All children progress at different rates but it is helpful if parents and carers know roughly when children should be mastering different skills in their learning of phonics. The guide below demonstrates **when** we expect children to master a certain level and the procedures in place to support this progress.

In all year groups progress is most rapid where children have thorough language experiences at home which include: listening to stories, playing phonics games, regularly going to the library and reading to an adult daily.
