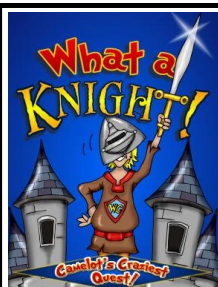

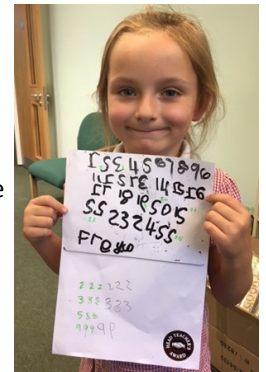
## Attendance Award

## Outstanding Work

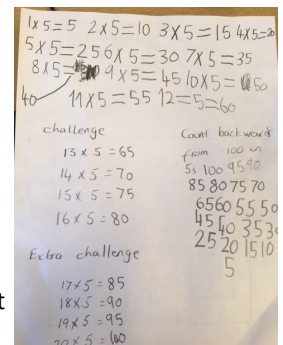
