Thank you for your vigilance in preparing for this beautiful weather; providing children with water, sun hats, sun cream and appropriate covering.

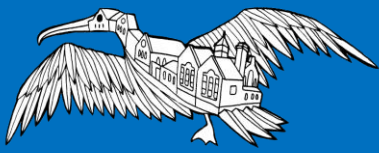
Nest Friday is Shuffle Up morning in school – children will meet their new class teachers and spend time in their new classrooms in preparation for September.
