Year 3 and Year 4 trip to the Sewage Treatment Works

On Friday 22 June, the Year 3 and 4 children enjoyed a fascinating day at Weston Super-Mare Sewage Treatment Works where they learnt about how dirty water is cleaned.

They were guided around the plant, and found out about the various stages of the process, first-hand. It was very interesting to see the baling machines creating giant bales of wet-wipes and other materials that don't belong in the sewerage system! The children particularly enjoyed walking over the top of a huge tank of water that was being cleaned using air bubbles.

There were lots of great questions during an indoor session where the children conducted a scientific fair test to investigate what happens to different paper products when they are flushed down the toilet.
