UNIFORM POLICY

A school uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school and setting an appropriate tone.

AIMS:

- To create a sense of pride in belonging to Milnrow Parish CE Primary School.
- To present a corporate image.
- To ensure that all children are dressed equally irrespective of their social or religious background.
- To ensure that all clothing, including shoes, contributes to the safety and well-being of pupils.

RATIONALE:

At Milnrow Parish we encourage children to wear a uniform as it can instill pride; support positive behaviour and discipline; encourage identity with, and support for, school ethos; ensure pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome; protect children from social pressures to dress in a particular way; and nurture cohesion and promote good relations between different groups of pupils. Parents are expected to help maintain the high standards of dress amongst pupils. Wearing the school uniform is part of this expectation.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

**Grey trousers, skirt or shorts** (not jogging bottoms or jeans)  
**White shirt** (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)  
**White polo shirt** (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)  
**School sweatshirt / Cardigan with logo**  
**School shoes in black or navy blue** (Please note trainers or boots are not allowed)  
**School tie Blue and Yellow stripe** (Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5)  
**School tie Gold** (Year 6 only supplied by school)  
**Blue gingham dress** (Summer Term only)

PE UNIFORM

Indoor / summer

**Navy shorts** (skorts or skirts are not acceptable)  
**Yellow T-shirt or polo shirt**  
**Pumps**

Outdoor

**Plain Navy blue / black tracksuit bottoms**  
**Plain navy blue / black tracksuit top / hoodie**  
**Trainers**

JEWELLERY

**Jewellery within school is discouraged. If children have pierced ears they must wear small studs or very small sleepers. These must be removed for PE or covered with tape. Children will not be allowed to wear necklaces, bracelets or rings. Children will be asked to remove these items, if worn, and they can be collected from their teacher at the end of the school day.**

HAIRSTYLES

**In order to promote a smart appearance no extreme hairstyles or colours of hair are allowed. This includes hair extensions and extreme patterns in hair. Long hair should be tied appropriately. Hair Accessories should be small and blue.**
