Discussed at this meeting

- Online safety questionnaire – quiz checked over by group and approved to be given out to pupils
- Jessica and Charlotte (PCSO) gave the group pictures of social media apps to look at. Everyone recognised YouTube! Jessica asked which members of the group were over 13 and told us that you are supposed to be over 13 before you are allowed to register on a social media site. The group were then given pictures of different people (including some celebrities) and were asked who they thought they could talk to online. The students all chose different people and gave reasons such as they look nice, they are famous, I like the Queen, the person with the cat as I like cats. Jessica and Charlotte explained that all these people are strangers and that sometimes people pretend to be someone else or pretend to like things that you do eg cats to try to be friends with you. We shouldn't talk to strangers. The students then watched a short CEOP video about how to behave on line – only talking to friends, not being mean and telling an adult if they weren't sure. Ryan was very clear when asked what to do if they weren't sure about something online and said to tell an adult.
