


ENGLISH

Throughout English lessons, we will look closely at many Greek Myths (including Icarus and King Midas) and use these to inspire us to write diaries from the viewpoint of a mythical character. We will also find out more information about the Trojan horse and take part in a debate to decide if the horse should've been welcomed or sent away.



MATHS

During maths lessons, we will continue to develop our knowledge of the four operations of number. We will begin to apply these to problem solving and reasoning tasks. There will be an introduction to fractions including making comparisons and calculating fractions of amounts. We will also be looking at the properties of 2D shapes including perimeter, area and angle sizes,

SCIENCE

In science, we will look at the digestive system in humans along with the functions of the teeth. We will learn more about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores and understand how these link to digestion. We will begin to gain a deeper understanding of food chains and their importance. During the second half term, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. We will identify vertebrates and invertebrates and use classification keys to help to categorise living things.

Gods and Mortals

PE

Throughout PE lessons, we will practise a range of multi skills to develop coordination. We will also have a try at different gymnastic activities whilst understanding the importance of keeping ourselves safe.

RE

We will explore what it means to be a Christian and the importance of belonging to God. We will also develop our understanding of how religious families and communities practise their faith.

COMPUTING

During this term, we will become confident with the schools acceptable use policy and the importance of SMART rules in keeping us safe online. We will learn how to keep ourselves protected by keeping personal information private and will know how to report upsetting or inappropriate information.

MUSIC

We will learn how to play the recorder with confidence and will also develop our skills in singing, notation and listening.

FRENCH

We have a specialised teacher who follows the French scheme of i-languages. They will work through the basic phrases, numbers and days of the week before moving onto more complex French.

HISTORY

We will become architects and become history detectives, trying to discover as much as we can through observation and discussion. Together we will study images of Greek soldiers to find out what they wore and the weapons they used to fight in battle. We will also look closer at famous battles and consider how the heroism has continued into

We will be trying to invent a pair of wings for Icarus which will be able to withstand the sun's heat. We will also study Greek patterns on plates and pottery.

WORSHIP

We will take part in daily worship to affirm the Christian Faith and knowledge of the Bible through the Anglican traditions.

GEOGRAPHY

Within Geography lessons, we will use maps and atlases to identify Greece but also look at how Ancient Greece looked and how it was different. We will look at images of the landscape and discuss similarities in the weather, terrain and settlements between Greece and Britain. We will also take a closer look into the island of Crete and investigate why the island is so popular with today's travellers.
