### New classes and staff for September 2018

#### Staff leaving:

We wish her well for the future as she has not only been a fantastic year 5 and 6 teacher but she has led music well within the school and many children have benefitted from her enthusiasm and dedication.
- We are happy to announce that following Mrs Taylor's commencement of maternity leave on Friday, she welcomed the arrival of a beautiful 7lb 9oz baby boy on Sunday morning! We send huge congratulations and are pleased to say that mum and son are both doing very well!
- Mrs Sahota will be commencing her maternity leave from the beginning of the autumn term and so she will not have an allocated class for next year. Again, we wish her well and look forward to seeing the new addition next term!

#### New staff appointments:
