PE and Sports Grant Impact Evaluation 2016-17

What impact we have seen on staff and pupils' PE and Sport participation, attainment and development of healthy lifestyles.

Activity/Investment	Impact
Teacher Professional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPD from external companies has increased staff confidence for teaching and assessing PE in both Key Stages. • Staff now teaching a wider variety in PE and incorporating fitness into each PE session.
Teaching Enhancement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increased provision of a wider range of resources is helping to enable teaching staff to differentiate learning within their classes and engage more children across all levels. • Increased resources also help to keep more children active at any one time, keeping active minds occupied and engaged on tasks. The wider range of resources has encouraged more children to be active and involved.
Learning Enhancement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Chance to Shine' cricket has given the children an opportunity to play a sport they may not have chosen to take part in before. Children were motivated, engaged and enjoyed their time with the coach. It was also a chance for Teacher CPD and gave ideas and confidence to teach cricket. • Launch of golf in school giving all children an insight into a new sport. Festival day was well received and children enjoyed the weekly sessions. Some children have been inspired to take this up as an additional sport. After school golf club was well attended by a range of children across both Key Stages. • Skip2bfit and Box2bfit days were engaged by all children. Every child in school was involved and learnt new skills. Teachers then used these ideas within their PE lessons to improve fitness- an area identified as a weakness. The Skip2fit 2 minute challenge was then launched and children in each class skipped every day for 2 minutes. Children were more focussed and ready for lessons. • Teachers/HLTAs have increased subject knowledge within Dance lessons. Teachers felt more confident in teaching dance and assessing children in this area.
Interschool Collaboration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children in all KS2 year groups participated in inter-school competitions and events throughout the year. Children in all year groups participated in a wide range of sports and activities with possibility of qualifying for

	<p>wider regional competitions. Activities included Cross Countries, Biathlons, Football Tournaments, Rugby Tournaments, Dodgeball Tournaments, Kwik Cricket Tournaments, Netball tournaments and more. 104% of children in KS2 engaged in extra curricular sporting activity every week with many participating in more than one activity.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High 5 netball has given children more opportunity to compete competitively in an area that they particularly enjoy. It has increased participation and motivation within the netball club and the children went on to compete in the finals.
