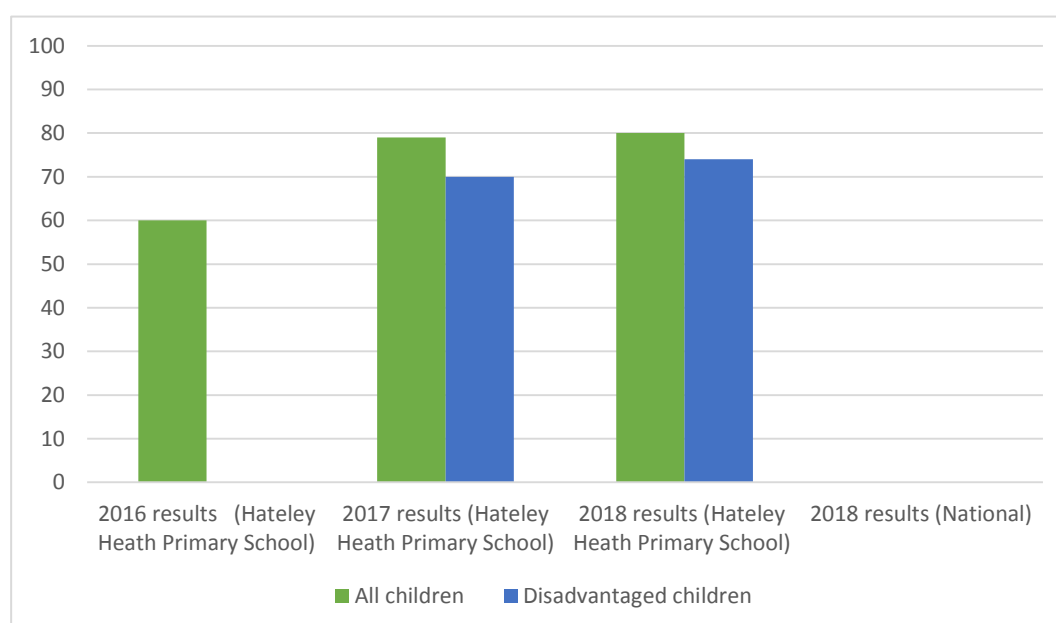


Phonics results 2017

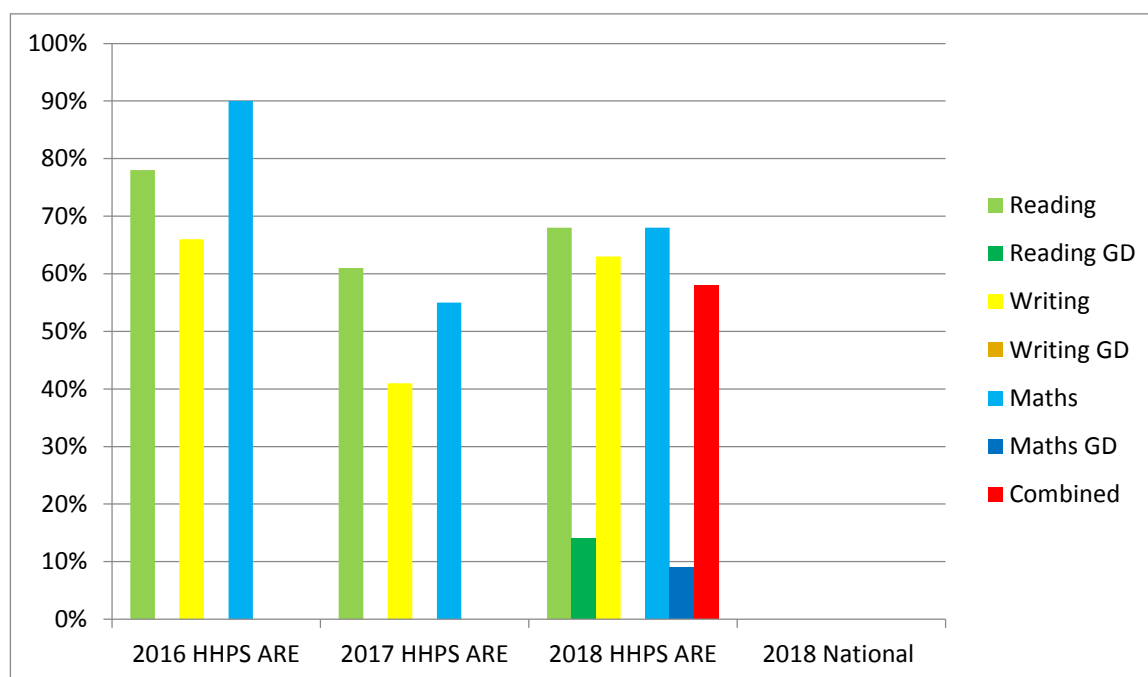

Within the past 3 years, the newly appointed practitioners who work across Early Years and KSI have implemented a number of teaching strategies which have seen a rise of almost 40% in the amount of pupils passing the phonics screening test. In 2017, 70% of pupil premium children passed the phonics screening test which is higher than national (68%). We will continue developing the above mentioned teaching strategies and our knowledge of Early Reading to increase the number of children who pass the Phonics Screening Test each year.

Having identified that Writing remains a weakness in KSI, we have successfully applied for a government funded writing scheme to ensure that we are able to significantly raise the attainment of pupils reaching the expected standard in Writing. With a complete overhaul in the way in which Maths is delivered in our school and the current percentage of pupils now leaving Reception at age related expectation, we will continue tackling underachievement until our standards replicate National standards.
